

FDCTA Open Show Awards Guidelines 2012

- 1. You must be a current FDCTA member in good standing. Your dues paid and the liability form signed. Forms and check must be received before your first competition.**
- 2. You must compete in three open shows and have scores from three different judges "L" level and above to be eligible for awards. One of the scores must be from the highest test offered.**
- 3. If you have won a division in the past, you may not enter the same division on the same horse. You are expected to move up to the next level. Since the tests for 2011 have been changed to three tests per level, you may re-enter the same level only if you have previously won the first two tests of the level. Those who have won the last two tests of the level must move up.**
- 4. Intro level may not enter any other division except for the In Hand Class.**
- 5. You may only enter two levels, and they must be consecutive.**
- 6. A horse and rider are considered a team. The same horse with a different rider may also be considered a team and can enter the same level or another level.**
- 7. You need to submit your scores by October 31 of the current year. A copy of the front of the test with the judges signature and the name of the horse, rider, and show are necessary.**
- 8. The scores will be calculated by adding the percentage scores and the highest number wins. The three scores must average 55% or better to qualify.**
