riders sign up the cost will go down

CAMP FEE INCLUDES:

stall and bedding
hay
use of arena
private or semi private lesson daily
afternoon lecture, demo or activity.

School horses will not be available. Horses attending camp must be sound at the walk, trot and canter.

Horses attending need to be in regular work (ie 3xs a week) for a month prior to camp. \$100.00 non refundable deposit is required by May 15th, (not cashed until camp), full payment on arrival at camp.

Camp will be limited to 10 riders per instructor. 2 & 3 day campers, you may choose which days you wish to ride but they must be consecutive days.

Signed camp registration form must be received prior to camp.

All scheduling and placement is to be determined by the instructors.

FDCTA Adult Camp Rules

Camp Rules:

1. Hardhats and boots are required at all times when mounted.
2. There is to be no riding if no instructors are on the premises.
3. No beer or liquor is allowed in any UF building.
4. Trash should be put in designated containers. No trash is to be put in manure pile or spreader.
5. Motorized scooters and carts are not permitted on the facility. Bicycles should not be ridden in the barns or arenas.
6. Water buckets are not to be dumped in the stall when leaving. Please dump outside or in the wash-rack drains.
7. Use only portable tack racks and hooks. No nails or hooks may be driven into the stalls.
8. Horses may not be ridden, walked or lunged in any grassy area. The small and outside arenas are available for use.
9. No parking of campers, trailers, cars or trucks in grassy areas in the front of the facility. (facing pond)
10. Campers are responsible for the care of their horse and stall while at camp. Stalls must be cleaned before leaving.
11. No smoking in any building - that includes the stall barns.
12. All dogs must be on a leash and attached to a human or tied to a trailer at all times.
13. ENJOY YOURSELF!

Other Important Information:

Feeders are provided in all stalls.

You may camp if you wish, but there is a charge if an electric hook-up is used. Check with the University for prices

You may arrive with your horse the night before you start camp.

A ride schedule will be assigned and sent out to campers the week before camp. This schedule is subject to change.

Remember, hay and bedding are provided. We also can use a couple of stalls for tack storage.

Snacks & drinks will be available throughout the day. (Coffee, hot & cold tea, water and probably carrots, apples etc.)

Fans are allowed in the barn. Bring extension cords.

You may want to bring a comfortable chair for relaxing.
